We are very pleased to welcome Nate Carr. Nate Carr attended Iowa State. There he had a career record of 117-20-1 in the 150 pound

weight class. He would earn three NCAA championships and two Big Eight Conference Titles. After graduation from Iowa State, Carr continued his freestyle wrestling career at the international level. In 1983 Carr earned a spot on the World Championship team. In 1986 he won both the World Cup and the Pan-American Championships. He began training for the 1988 Olympic Games in Seoul while working as an assistant coach at West Virginia University. At the Games he wrestled to the semifinal match and won a bronze medal. He returned as a member of the World Championship team in 1990 and also won his weight class at the Goodwill Games in Russia.
