The annual Kentucky USAW FolkStyle Belt Series is open to contestants of all ages and from all states. The division belt winners will be determined by the outcome of the Three (3) tournaments that makeup the KY USA Wrestling Belt Series.

There will be 8 divisions (Bantam, Midget, Novice, Schoolboy, Cadet, Junior, University, & Open). Wrestlers compete to win the division belt by accumulating the greatest number of possible points (45 pts) from the 3 tournaments in the Belt Series. Wrestlers must compete in all of the 3 tournaments to qualify for the Championship Belt. [Soft Break][Soft Break] Wrestlers score points by placing in the top 4 at each of the individual tournaments. The scoring system will be as follows:

1st place = 15 pts

2nd place = 12 pts

3rd place = 9 pts

4th place = 7 pts

**(A contestant that has no opponents in their particular weight class will only accumulate 6 points) Participants will have the opportunity to wrestle up or down to get a match if there are no other opponents in your weight class if available.**

[Soft Break] Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>) at each individual tournament. A high quality, "Championship Belt" will be presented to the "Top" finisher in each division at the conclusion of the "Gable Belt Series".

**Format:** Double Elimination. If there is less than 5 entries in a particular weight class, a "Round Robin" format will be used.

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 check made out to Horsepower Wrestling Club

**Admission:** \$5 - adults

\$2 - 12 & under

Free - 6 and under

Coolers and outside food will be charged an additional \$5 at the door.

Bantam – Schoolboy (Midget-Schoolboy required headgear)

## SESSION 2

Cadet – Open

**Registration and weigh-in from 11:30am-12:30pm** - Wrestling from 1:30PM-5:30PM

**Early Weigh Ins:** We will have weigh ins at Moore on Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup> from 5pm – 7pm. There will be other remote weigh-ins available and they will be posted on KentuckyWrestling.com when dates and times are known. Look under EVENTS. If your club would like to do a remote weigh-in then please let us know.

**Registration:** Each wrestler must have a USA Wrestling card available at themat.com. You will be able to purchase a card at the door for \$30. We will take forms early but we will NOT take money until the morning of the tournament. Everyone will pay at the door before coming back to check in.
