## General Information

*Camps are open to any and all participants.*

### Registration

Pre-registration by all campers is recommended by May 15th. Registration will continue after May 15th only if space is available. *Provide an e-mail address to receive confirmation of your application and a checklist of necessary items.*

### Check-in/Check-out

Check-in: 3-5 p.m. on the first day of camp.  
Check-out: 4-5 p.m. on the last day of camp.

### Facilities

Camps will be held in the In IU Athletic Facilities on IU Campus"

### Housing and Meals

Campers will be housed in the IU dormitories, a short distance from the wrestling facility. All rooms are air-conditioned, and two wrestlers will be assigned to a room. Unless a specific roommate is requested, wrestlers will be housed with campers of similar age. Meals will be prepared and served in the dining facilities on the IU campus. **No dinners are served the first day of camp after check in.**

### Supervision

Campers will be supervised during all organized activities. Camp counselors will reside in the same dorms as the campers. A certified athletic trainer will be on duty at all sessions. In case of emergency, both Bloomington Hospital and the IU Health Center are within minutes of the camp facilities.

### Camp Insurance

Indiana Wrestling Camps provide access to accident/medical.

### Deposit and Balance

A non-refundable deposit of \$150 is required with each application. The balance is due at check-in. We will accept applications only up to our enrollment limit, on a first-come basis. Applications accepted at check-in must be paid in full. No refunds after check-in.
