PROPOSAL Y-10 Youth Weigh in process for Youth State	CIRCLE CHOICE

a. Each Wrestlers birth certificate to confirm birth year	
b. Each wrestlers USA Card	
c. Each wrestlers weight via youth weigh in (using at least one certified official)	
d. Send wrestler name, team, birth year and weight to KSWA for entry into the Youth State Tournament Brackets by the following Monday evening of the Youth Regional Event.	
Option 2 – KSWA will hold a Youth Weigh in the Friday/Saturday before the youth State Tournament at a location to be determined by the KSWA. All wrestlers must weigh in at one of these weigh ins BEFORE the youth state tournament. Failure to weigh in will result in removal from the tournament. KSWA will define the parameters of the weigh in 30 days prior to the youth state tournament.	Option 2
