**Entry Fee:**

- \$16 per wrestler – nonrefundable – Fee paid at registration. You must pay for all wrestlers entered on Trackwrestling.com. Make check payable to KYUSA Wrestling. **Each team must pay with one check for all wrestlers when paying day of.**
- **\$24 per wrestler after February 1, 2020 at 11PM.**

**Eligibility:**

- Age Groups: Peewee- 2014-2015, Bantam- 2012-2013, Intermediate 2010-2011, Novice- 2008-2009, Middle School- 8/1/2005-2007 (See Trackwrestling.com for weight classes)
- Must be a permanent Kentucky resident, and be enrolled in a Kentucky school system (or accredited home school).
- Must have a current Kentucky USA wrestling league card or a current full USA wrestling membership card.
- Must have all paperwork in place and fees paid with Kentucky USA wrestling.
- Must wrestle in your youth regional tournament.

**Registration:**

- Each team must submit their own roster on Trackwrestling.com by Monday January 27, 2020.
- Wrestlers must be entered into the KFWC Youth State Tournament on Trackwrestling.com.
- No late entries will be allowed.
- **Middle School State placers (top 6) are NOT eligible for this tournament.**

**Admission:**

- Adults: \$10, Students: \$5.
- Coaches must present USA Coaches Card and have completed Bylaw Acknowledgement in order to receive Coaches Bands. Coaches bands can be picked up at the time of team registration and payment.
- Only wrestlers and coaches with bands allowed access to the arena floor.

**Schedule:**

- Session 1 Age Groups: **Peewee, Bantam, and Novice**
- Wrestler and Coach check-in from 7:00 am – 8:00 am
- Wrestling 8:30 am – 12 noon
- Session 2 Age Groups: **Intermediate and Middle School**
- Wrestler and Coach check-In from 7:30 am – 12 noon
- Wrestling 1:15 pm – 5:00 pm

**Format**

- 16 man brackets Double elimination.
- Three (3) sixty (60) second periods
- Awards for 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> individuals in 9-16 man brackets.  
1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> individuals in 1-8 man brackets
